Application Instructions and Check List

The student application and all supporting recommendations, forms, and documents must be submitted online no later than Thursday, May 31, 2018.

The application must be completed online at this link: https://www.tfaforms.com/309675

No late or partial applications will be considered.

You will need to upload copies of the following documents as a part of the student application:

- ✓ Official or unofficial High School Transcript
 (You can request your transcript from the School's Registrar or Guidance Office.)
- ✓ 2017 Federal Tax Return (IRS Form 1040 including W2 form and all Schedules), and/or proof of government assistance (provided by you or your parents.)
- ✓ Citizenship/Immigration Status Documentation (e.g., Birth Certificate, Social Security Card, Passport, Green Card, or Visa). Please note - this documentation is required if you are a US Citizen/Dual, US Permanent Resident, or US Visa Holder. If you have any other immigration status, including being an undocumented immigrant, no documentation is required.

In addition to the online student application, you will need to have ALL of the following recommendations and forms submitted online on your behalf on or before May 31, 2018:

- ✓ One Teacher Recommendation (Please, do not submit more than one.)
 - Once you have selected a teacher, please provide them with this link: https://www.tfaforms.com/309754
- ✓ **One Adult Personal Reference Recommendation** (Please, do not submit more than one.) (Examples of adult personal references may include another teacher, guidance counselor, principal, YMCA coordinator, or pastor, etc., as long as they are not related to you.)
